## August Minutes

SCOS member Stan Hutto prepared an interesting presentation of the genera *Lycaste*, *Anguloa* and *Ida*. Stan's original intent was to present a slide show prepared by Orchid Digest, however the presentation proved to be woefully out of date with numerous slides of dubious quality. With typical grace, Stan whipped the presentation into a sweeping walk through this beautiful group.

Stan led a discussion, along with Tom Nasser and Gene Crocker, of the merits and methods of growing this group of plants under our conditions. Suggestions included using a porous mix with sphagnum and perlite, plentiful water and moderate feeding during the growth season, and not allowing the plants to become desiccated during the winter rest.

During the refreshment break, the Board members met for a quick meeting. A donation to the AOS Conservation Fund in the amount of \$50 was approved in memory of Jack Webster. In addition, the society has purchased the last edition of *Orchids of Ecuador* which will be inscribed in Jack's memory.

Two other Board actions were discussed and approved. The Society will provide the entree for the luncheon at the Lawrence's during our September road trip. Also, the newsletter will move to a bi-monthly format with email reminders on alternate months.

In addition to announcements of the Board actions, business discussed during the open session included our plans to participate in the Coastal Carolina show on the weekend of Oct. 24-26. ## September Meeting

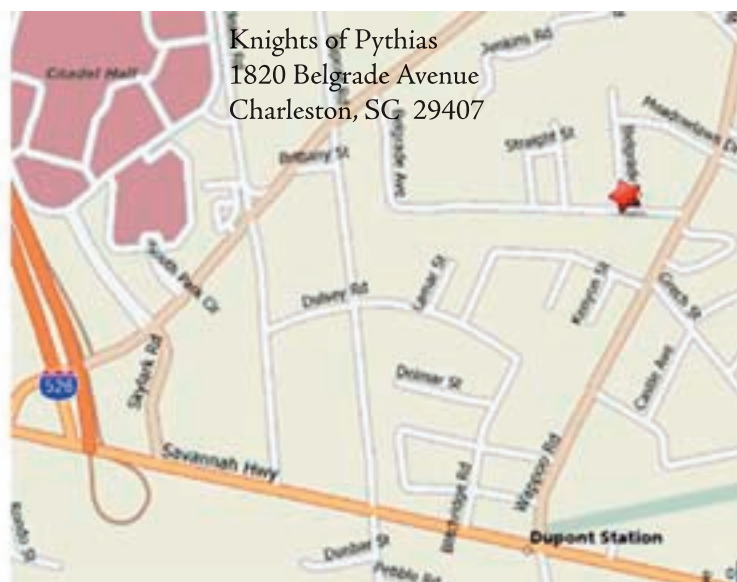

If you have a GPS unit, follow the directions to 909 Hwy 252 in Belton, SC

Most members will be coming from the southern parts of the state via I-26, so I'll start with a fairly common reference point - the intersection of Hwy. 34 and I-26 in beautiful Newberry, SC.

I-26 22.1 mi to 385, LEFT toward Laurens/Greenville

I-385 22.8 Miles to SC-418, EXIT 23, toward FOUNTAIN INN/PELZER. 0.3 mi

LEFT onto MCCARTER RD/SC-418. Follow SC-418 11.6 mi

Turn LEFT onto AUGUSTA RD/US-25/CHARLES AIKEN HWY. for 0.1 mi

Turn RIGHT onto COOLEY BRIDGE RD/SC-247.

Continue to follow SC-247 10.6 mi

Turn LEFT onto N MAIN ST/SC-20, Belton

In 0.1 mi turn RIGHT onto ANDERSON ST/US-178/US-76/SC-20. Continue to follow US-178 W/US-76 W. for 4.5 mi

Turn LEFT onto EDNEY RD.

In 0.4 mi EDNEY RD. ends at a stop sign.

Turn slight LEFT onto HONEA PATH HWY/SC-252. In appx. 1 mile, you will find the Lawrence's driveway on the LEFT at 909 Highway 252 Belton, SC 29627-8128

To Janvrin's from Lawrence's

Back onto Hwy 252, Right toward Anderson.

Instead of turning right onto EDNEY RD., continue slightly LEFT on Hwy. 252

Merge onto US-178 W/US-76 W. (aka Anderson St., aka Belton Hwy, Aka River St.) for 5.0 mi

Turn RIGHT onto S FANT ST. 0.4 mi Map Avoid

Follow S. Fant for 0.4 mi.

Just past the train tracks Turn RIGHT onto E ORR ST.

636 E Orr is appx. 0.5 mi on the RIGHT

Please park in the grassy area on the uphill side of the house.

IF FOLLOWING A GPS UNIT OR MAPQUEST MAP, THE HOUSE IS ACTUALLY A BLOCK EAST OF THE INDICATED LOCATION.
